**To make a bequest to WFA, the following language will be helpful to your lawyer:**

I give, devise, and bequeath to the Women's Foundation of Arkansas (WFA) the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ (or otherwise describe the gift or specify a percentage of the estate).

**Three simple ways that you can make a bequest:**

Specific Bequest

You designate a specific dollar amount, specific percentage, or specific property to WFA.

Residual Bequest

Your estate will pay all debts, taxes, expenses, and specific bequests. The remaining amount--the residue--will be transferred to WFA.

Contingent Bequest

You can ask that WFA receive all or a portion of your estate only under certain circumstances. For example, you can name WFA as a beneficiary of your estate only if there are no surviving close family members. Childless couples sometimes provide for the entire estate to go to the surviving spouse, or if the spouse does not survive, to WFA.
